



Living Choice Orientation

Before Decision to Participate

Review the following information with the Individual:

1. Philosophy of Living Choice Demonstration Project
2. Purpose of Living Choice Demonstration Project
3. Services available in Living Choice Demonstration Project
4. Eligibility requirements
5. Participant Rights and Responsibilities

Ask the individual if he/she is interested in participating in LCDP

After Decision to Participate

1. Ask Participant to sign the Consents and Rights Form, indicating choice to participate in LCDP
2. Review and document the following:
 - LCDP Participant Assurances
 - How to report abuse, neglect or exploitation
 - Provider Agency's complaint and grievance process
 - Provider Agency's 24 hour emergency contact information
 - Possible risks of participation in LCDP
3. Review and leave a copy of the following documents with the Participant:
 - OKHCA Member Complaint/Grievance Form
 - OKDHS Request for a Fair Hearing
 - Living Choice Demonstration Project Brochure
 - Personal Business Card
4. Complete the Service Team Release of Information Form

After Decision to NOT Participate

1. Provide contact information in the event the individual changes his/her mind at a later date
2. Ask the individual to sign the Consents and Rights Form, indicating choice to not participate
